Progress

This table shows the **progress** that children made between Key Stage 1 (Year 2) and Key Stage 2 (Year 6)

These scores are calculated by comparing the Key Stage 2 assessment results of pupils in schools across England who started with similar assessment results at the end of Key Stage 1.

Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2 Reading	-1.0	-4.1 and 2.1
Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2 Writing	-0.3	-3.3 and 2.7
Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2 Mathematics	-1.1	-3.9 and 1.7

A score of zero means that children, on average, made the expected progress between Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2.

A score of more than zero means that children made more than expected progress between Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2.

A score of below zero means that the children made more than expected progress between Key Stage 1 and Key Stage 2.

Average Scaled Score

This table shows the **average scaled score** achieved by children. This shows an average score for pupils in the cohort. The expected standard is a score of 100 or more. The higher standard (Greater Depth) is 110 or more.
