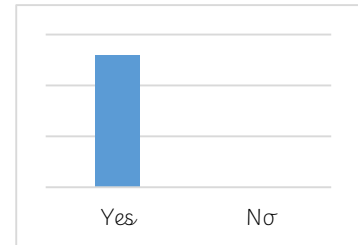




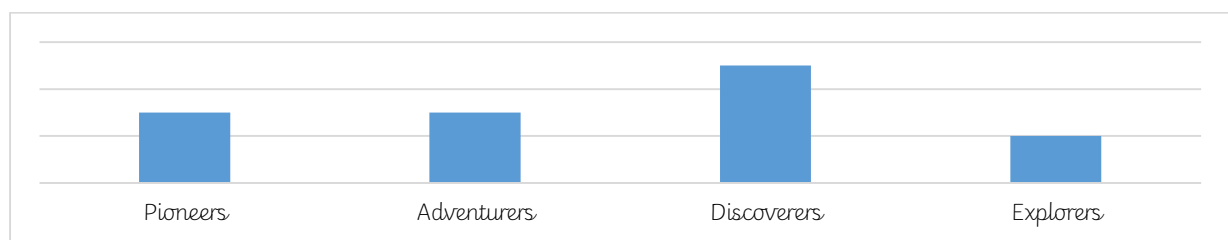
**Sleights Church of England Primary School
