# News from Sleights

I wanted to thank families for their brilliant efforts in making sure children are on time and ready to learn every day. The gate is locked at 9am every morning and it is great to know that our children are safely in and starting work. Thank you for your continued support with this!

Having discovered different senses, this week the children in **Explorers** have begun to find out and talk about different emotions. Using the book Colour Monster, the children have been identifying different emotions around them and exploring how colours can be used to help with this. The children have had a great time showing different emotions using their own faces too, with some great ideas and results.

I have been blown away by some amazing writing this week in the **Pioneers.** The children have also been busy showcasing their incredible reading. I have been really impressed to see their progress and enjoyment. A real joy this week has been hearing from families how the children and showcasing their skills at home too. It is great to see such great partnership work in action!

In **Learners**, the children were keen to tell me how much they had enjoyed writing newspaper reports and starting to learn about different houses. The children were really enthusiastic to share how much they had also enjoyed developing printing skills in art too.

The **Adventurers** spent a brilliant day in the forest on Wednesday. Whilst it was chilly, the children enjoyed using natural materials to make replicas of Stone Age houses, linked to their history unit. The children told me they thought carefully about selecting the materials they needed and enjoyed their building task.

In **Discoverers**, the children have enjoyed their science topic of living things and their habitats, where the children have been looking at how things grow. The children have also enjoyed publishing their newspaper reports and discovering houses with Tudor features to inspire their writing next week.

Finally, in **Leaders**, the children have been busy learning about fractions and rocks. In English, the children have been excited to start work planning their own Right Move style housing adverts for Tudor properties. The children have been studying different examples of adverts, including some from local agents **Henderson's** - more on that next week!
