Mathematics			
<b>We will be building fluency, reasoning and problem solving in:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Mass and capacity, fractions, money, time, shape and statistics.</li><li>• Adventurers will explore mass and capacity by using scales. They will measure and compare mass in grams and kilogram and measure capacity and volume in litres and millimetres.</li><li>• When learning about fractions, year 3 will add and subtract fractions as well as partitioning the whole.</li><li>• Adventurers will explore money by looking at converting pounds and pence. They will learn how to add and subtract money and find change.</li><li>• Year 3 will learn how to tell the time to 5 minutes and the minute. They will read time on a digital clock and solve problems with time. They will also learn their Roman numerals to 12.</li><li>• When exploring shape, Adventurers will compare angles and measure and draw accurately. They will learn about horizontal and vertical and parallel and perpendicular.</li><li>• Adventurers will focus on drawing pictograms and bar charts in statistics and collect and represent data.</li></ul>			<b>Our times table focus this term will be:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• 4 times table</li><li>• 6 times table</li></ul>

<p>Our key topics this term are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Careers Education and Person Finance</li><li>Emotional Health and Wellbeing</li><li>First Aid (including first aid training from the My Mini Medics Team in Discoverers and Leaders)</li><li>Water Safety</li></ul>	<p>Our key topics this term are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>What kind of world did Jesus want?</li><li>What can we learn from religions about deciding what is right and wrong?</li></ul>	<p>Our units this term are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li><b>States of Matter</b> – Adventurers will explore what does 'states of matter' mean and how matter can change. They will take part in experiments using solids, liquids and gasses and learn about the water cycle.</li><li><b>Materials</b> – Adventurers will learn about the different properties of materials and how they can be used for different purposes. They will explore friction and how forces can change a shape. Furthermore, they will find out about Isambard Kingdom Brunel and why he is famous.</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Spellings are sent home every 2 weeks.
