- Unstressed vowels in polysyllabic words
- Homophones and other words that are often confused

We will be building fluency, reasoning and problem solving in:

- Place Value
  - Using numbers up to 1,000,000
- Addition & Subtraction
  - With of a focus on addition and subtraction of whole numbers with more than four digits
- Multiplication & Division
  - We will look at factors, multiples, prime, square, cube numbers, multiply and divide by 10, 100 and 1000
- Fractions
  - Comparing, ordering, adding and subtracting fractions
