

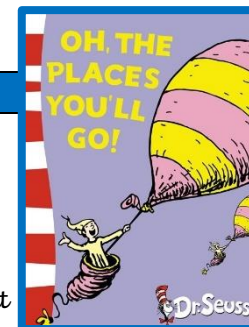

"The Places You Will Go!" Summer 2025 - Discoverers

In this unit, we will be exploring the key ideas of thinking big and aspiration. To help guide our discussions with the children, we will be inspired by lots of activities and texts, including the book "Oh, The Places You Will Go!", written by Dr Seuss.



English

We will be writing:

- A narrative to entertain
- Inspired by Shakespeare's 'A Midsummer Night's Dream', we will create character profiles and retell key events in newspaper reports.
- A report to celebrate families and important values for our Family Service in St John's Church.
- Book reviews to celebrate our favourite texts of the year.

We will be learning to spell:

- adding suffixes - words ending in - ant, ance/ancy, ent, ence, ency
- i before e except after c when the sound is /ee/
- meaning of different prefixes & how that impacts on the meaning of the word
- Spellings will be sent home on a Thursday and then tested on a Tuesday

We will be reading:

- Gargantis - Herbie and Violet's next adventure at Eerie-on-Sea.

Mathematics

We will be building fluency, reasoning and problem solving in:

- Statistics (drawing and interpreting graphs, tables and timetables)
- Geometry - Shape, position and direction (Lines, angles, shapes and using coordinates)
- Number - Decimals and negative numbers (Understanding negative numbers and calculating with decimals)
- Measurement - Volume and converting units (Converting a range of different units and measuring volume)

Our times table focus this term will be:

- A mixture of all times tables to 12 x 12

Art and Design

We will be focusing on collage. Using a range of materials and sewing techniques to plan and create an appliqué design.

- Our focus artists are **Ben Lewis Giles** and **Andrew Hannah Höch**

Computing

Mrs Gurney will teach us about:

- animation, using iMovie and Microbits.

Design and Technology

We will be carrying out projects linked to:

- Cooking and Nutrition, including (adapting a traditional recipe, understanding that the nutritional value of the recipe alters before designing, making and evaluating their own version of the recipe)
