

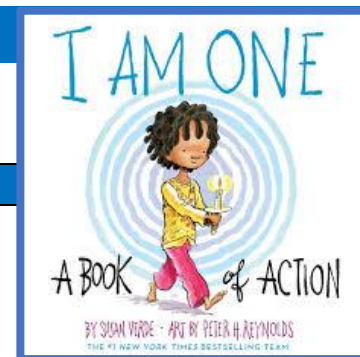

We will be writing:

- a poster to inform

We will be learning to spell:

- This term, we will be introducing a new spelling scheme for children in Year 3, 4, 5 and 6. More information about 'The Spelling Shed' will be sent home shortly.
- We will focus on: words using the digraph 'ou', words ending in ture and sure, words with prefixes and words ending ing, er or ed.
- In Key Stage Two, spellings will be sent home on a Friday, for a test the following Friday.

We will be reading:

- Nim's Island by Wendy Orr
- Poetry from The Works collection, by Pie Corbett
- The Giraffe and The Pelly and Me by Roald Dahl.

Mathematics

We will be building fluency, reasoning and problem solving in:

- Place Value including numbers to 1000.
- Addition and Subtraction including 1s, 10s and 100s.
- Multiplication and Division including 2s, 5s, 10s, 3s, 4s and 8s.

Our times table focus this term will be:

- Doubles
- 2 x tables
- Square times tables.

Art and Design

- We will be focusing on drawing.
- Our focus artists are Dante Rossetti and Vincent Van Gogh.

Computing

Mrs Gurney will teach us about:

- e-safety and touch typing.
