

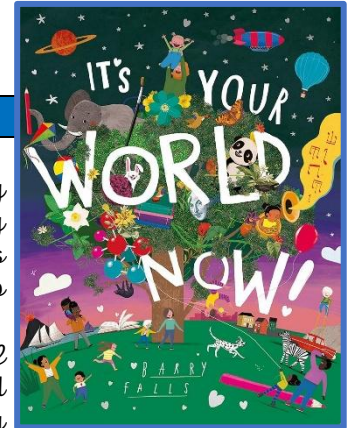

<p>We will be building fluency, reasoning and problem solving in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fractions – we will be learning how to add and subtract fractions as well as calculating fractions of amounts. Money – we will learn how to add and subtract money and to convert amounts of money. Time – we will be learning about units of time and will learn how to tell the time up to one minute. Shape – we will be learning about angles, 2D and 3D shapes.
