

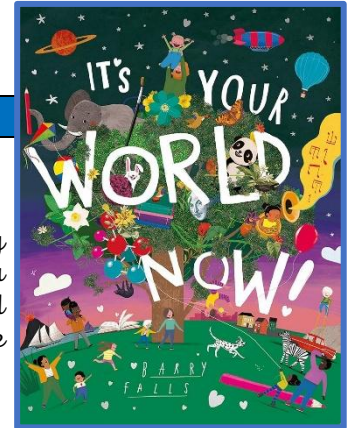

"It's Your World Now!" Summer 2026 - Discoverers

In this unit, the children will use the book "It's Your World Now!" to inspire some of their work. The book focuses on thoughts about moving on and aspiration. As we move to the end of the school year, this is a great chance to reflect on the successes of the year and the big steps ahead.



English

We will be writing:

- Poetry and narrative, inspired by William Shakespeare's 'Macbeth'
- A newspaper report, to inform
- A letter, to persuade
- A review, to discuss

We will be learning to spell:

- Year 4s will focus on homophones, words with 'c' before 'i' and 'e', prefixes 'super', 'anti', 'auto', words with possessive apostrophes and finally words containing 'phon', 'sign', 'sot' and 'real'.
- Year 5s will focus on homophones or near homophones, words with hyphens and challenge words.
- In Key Stage Two, spellings will be sent home on a Friday, for a test the following Friday.

We will be reading:

- The Last Bear written by Michael Morpurgo and a variety of poems and rhymes chosen by Pie Corbett.

Mathematics

We will be building fluency, reasoning and problem solving in:

- Year 4s will be focusing on decimals, money, time, shape, statistics and position and direction. Year 4 will also be focusing on strengthening their times tables knowledge in preparation for their Multiplication Tables Check.
- Year 5s will be focusing on shape, position and direction, decimals, negative numbers, converting units and volume.

This term we will be revising all multiplication facts 12x12. Please encourage your child to use Multiplication Checker weekly to support their learning.

Art and Design

- We will be focusing on **sculpture**.
- Year 4 focus artists are **Yayoi Kusama** and **Elisabeth Frink**.
- Year 5 focus artists are **Anthony Gormley** and **Emma Stothard**.
