

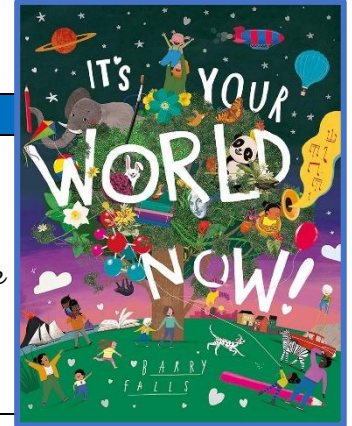


Sleights Church of England (Voluntary Controlled) Primary School

English

We will be writing:

- Poetry and narrative, inspired by William Shakespeare's 'Macbeth'
- A newspaper report, to inform
- A letter, to persuade
- A review, to discuss

We will be learning to spell:

- Words with the prefix - over, words with the suffix - ful, words with unstressed vowel sounds, and words which can be nouns and verbs.
- In Key Stage Two, spellings will be sent home on a Friday, for a test the following Friday.

We will be reading:

- Letters from the Lighthouse by Emma Carroll

Mathematics

We will be building fluency, reasoning and problem solving in:

- Geometry - shape
- Geometry - position, direction and movement
- Problem solving

Our times table focus this term will be:

- Consolidation of all times table facts

Art and Design

- We will be focusing on **sculpture**.
