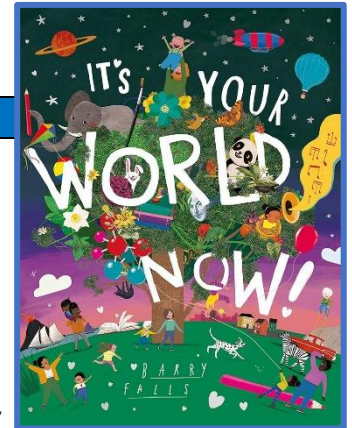




"It's Your World Now!" Summer 2026 - Learners

In this unit, the children will use the book "It's Your World Now!" to inspire some of their work. The book focuses on thoughts about moving on and aspiration. As we move to the end of the school year, this is a great chance to reflect on the successes of the year and the big steps ahead.



English

We will be writing:

- Poetry and narrative, inspired by William Shakespeare's 'Macbeth'
- A newspaper report, to inform
- A letter, to persuade
- A review, to discuss

We will be learning these spelling rules:

- The 'w special' How do 'w' and 'qu' change the sounds that 'a', 'ar' and 'or' make in some words?
- Why do I swap the 'y' for an 'i' when I add the suffix -es?
- Why do some words have the spelling 'ey' for the sound /ee/?
- Why do some words end -le, -al, -il or -el?
- Why does 'c' make the sound /s/ in some words?
- How can I spell the sound /zh/?
- What happens when I add the suffixes -ment, -ness, -ful -less and -ly to a root word?
- How can I show missing letters in a word?

We will be reading:

Dinosaur in Disguise by Jeanne Willis and
Daisy and the Trouble with Zoos by Kes Gray

Mathematics

We will be building fluency, reasoning and problem solving in:

Year One:

- Multiplication and Division – counting in 2s, 5s and 10s
- Fractions – finding a half and a quarter of an object and a quantity
- Place Value within 100 – one more, one less, making numbers within 100.
- Position and direction
- Money
- Time

Year Two:

- Fractions – finding a half, quarter, three quarters and a third
- Time
- Statistics
- Position and direction

Our times table focus this term will be:
2s, 5s and 10s
