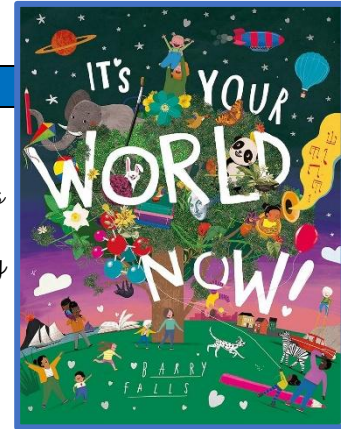




"It's Your World Now!" Summer 2026 - Pioneers
