

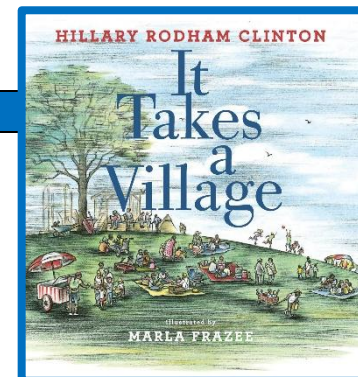

Year 3 spellings will include: - ou, y, sure, ture, - Prefixes - re-, dis-, -mis, - Suffixes -ing, -ed, -er, -en - In Key Stage Two, spellings will be sent home on a Friday, for a test the following Friday.	We will be reading: Iron Man by Ted Hughes
